

# How To Get A Study Visa For Australia?

One of the largest countries in the world and the smallest continent, Australia, is a dream destination. Australia, the largest country in Oceania, comprises of 7,686,850 square kilometres with the population of 26 million. It has the largest area of ocean jurisdiction of any country on Earth with no land borders. Australia's neighbouring countries include Solomon Islands, Indonesia, New Zealand, East Timor, Vanuatu, and Papua New Guinea. Climate, mostly governed by its size and the hot, sinking air of the subtropical high pressure belt, Australia suffers frequent droughts which last several seasons. The northern part of the country has a tropical climate whereas the south-east and south-west have a temperate climate.

Thousands of years before the arrival of the British, Australia was inhabited by the Aborigines, the original inhabitants of the country and the world's oldest living cultural civilisation. The first European to land at the island was Captain Willem Janszoon, a Dutch explorer in 1606. Afterwards, a British explorer Captain James Cook landed at Botany Bay in New South Wales in 1770, who then proceeded to map the eastern coast of Australia, claiming it for Great Britain. British assumed that Aborigines would abandon their land and they could easily explore it for making it as their new colony. However, they retaliated which resulted in battles between both the sides and the Aborigines were no match for modern British weaponry. Australia became fully independent from the United Kingdom in 1986. Today, Australia is prosperous country and is now the 14<sup>th</sup> largest economy in the world.

Known globally for having one of the world's best education systems, Australia is much more than just kangaroos. World-class quality education, great standard of living, post-study work opportunities, makes Australia one of the most preferable destinations for Indian students. Australian universities are globally recognized for their academic excellence, with seven of them being consistently ranked in the top 100 of the QS World Ranking. Be it humanities, engineering, law or science, Australian institutions offer a wide range of courses and ranks among the world's best by discipline. There are 43 universities in Australia including one private specialty university, 40 Australian universities and two international universities. ## **Study Visa Australia Requirements**

However, for studying in the world-class universities of Australia, you need to have a study visa. **Requirements for study visa Australia** are as follows –

1. Electronic CoE (Confirmation of Enrolment).
2. You need to provide a proof for your English language proficiency i.e. qualify IELTS/TOEFL test.
3. You must have a good character and submit a police clearance certificate.
4. Evidence that you have sufficient funds for your course fee, airfares, and living costs.
5. **Australia study visa fee.**
6. **Australia study visa** application form.
7. A valid passport and 4 passport-sized photos.
8. If you were earlier employed then you need to provide the proof such as employment contract, pay checks etc.
9. You are also required to provide a proof of health insurance cover.
10. You must be able to prove that your stay in Australia is only temporary and not permanent.
11. After getting your study visa, you can enter Australia up to 90 days before the commencement of your course.
12. You must inform about your residential address to your education provider within seven days of your arrival. In case, you change your address, you need to inform them again within seven days.
13. While on a student visa, you can work up to 40 hours per fortnight during term time and full-time in the holidays.

## **English Language Requirements for Study Visa Australia**

Australian colleges and universities accept both PTE as well as IELTS scores to test your skills in English proficiency. The table below outlines the guidelines for IELTS/PTE score. This is just an approximation as each institute has their own benchmark score for their respective courses.

### **Study Visa Australia Procedure**

You need to submit your application for Australia student visa 12 weeks prior to the orientation date of the course you have opted for. The **process for filing the Australia student visa** application form is as follows –

1. The student must obtain an Offer Letter/Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) before applying for the **Australia student visa** confirming that he/she has been accepted into a course program registered under the Commonwealth Register of Institution of Courses (CRICOS).
2. The **study visa for Australia** can be applied online. However, you need to visit the given website and create an account there – <https://online.immi.gov.au/lusc/register>  
After creating an account, you are required to fill the application form corresponding to the visa subclass under which you are eligible to apply for, then attach the documents and pay the **Australia study visa fee** online.
3. Based on the course you have opted for and the region you are going to study at, you will be required to complete a health check-up and you will receive the information for that after you have submitted your application form. A TRN i.e Transaction Reference Number is required to complete the procedure, therefore, do not conduct a health check-up before that. You need to have your medical check-up completed by a certified doctor so as to complete your form.

### **Study Visa Australia Fee**

After successfully submitting your visa application, you need to deposit the visa fee. The **Australia study visa fee from India** is AUD\$ 606. All the online services and applications are charged in Australian dollars. American Express, MasterCard, VISA are the acceptable credit cards. However, if you pay by a credit card in Australian dollars, you may incur banking as well as currency conversion fees and need to accept the risk related to any currency fluctuations.

After submitting the visa fee, the Australian government will allocate you a TRN for the application with which you can easily track the status of your visa application online.

### **Study Visa Australia Processing Time**

Usually, the processing time for Australia study visa application is 1-5 weeks. You can easily track your application from the immigration website. The representatives of the Australian immigration will also notify you about the decision via e-mail.

### **Study Visa Australia After Refusal**

From the past few years, there has been a tremendous increase in student visa applications for Australia. However, there have been many instances where the applications for **Australia study visa** get rejected. Following can be some of the reasons for **Australian student visa rejection** –

1. Incomplete/Fake/Incorrect documents.
2. Insufficient funds to support your tuition, living and other costs in Australia.
3. If you have any criminal records.
4. Inadequate skills in English language proficiency.
5. Health issues.
6. Inadequate proof that you will come back to India after you complete your course in Australia.
7. If the course you have opted seems unrelated to your educational background.
8. Shady immigration history.

### **Study Visa Australia Re-Apply**

If your **study visa application for Australia** gets refused, you can re-apply again. However, before applying for the Australia study visa again, you need to address the reasons why it was refused.
